- Available weekly for 3 hours from April-October. Days of attendance can be flexible to suit.
- Keen to learn or have some gardening experience.
- Happy in the outdoors in all weathers!

- Full training and induction will be provided and a volunteer supervisor will support you in your role.
- We provide equipment to help you do this role well and safely.
- Some manual handling and bending/working at low levels will be required in this role.
- A volunteer supervisor will check in regularly with this role, however volunteers will be expected to carry out day to day duties unsupervised.
- No references are required for this role, applicants will be expected to complete a Criminal Convictions Declaration Form.
