The River Ayr Way is Scotland's first Source to Sea medium to long distance routes. It is included in the national family of 'Scotland's Great Trails and is used by over 120,000 people each year who either do the route in its entirety or explore individual sections of the route. The River Ayr Way runs to the north of Stair.

COMMUNITY LED FACILITIES



Stair Community Centre is owned and managed by Stair Community Association. The Centre provides recreational facilities for use by community groups and the general public and includes a programme of community events including music, guizzes and bingo nights. It also hosts regular activities including sport and leisure classes such as Yoga and Pilates. The Centre has five rooms available for hire. The Rural Room offers a carpeted space for committee meetings, group activities and talks. The Drill Hall can be carpeted for yoga and meetings or a wooden floor for ceilidhs, dances or sports activities. The Church Room can be used for meetings, group activities, as a small auditorium staged space and is equipped with a wall mounted screen for presentations and film shows. The room capacity can be increased by opening the partition into the Drill Hall for larger events and family parties The Young Farmers Room offers a carpeted space for meetings or group activities. The Kitchen provides an accessible space for social

gatherings and craft activities. There are also facilities to make refreshments and to heat food.
