- Friendly, chatty and someone who enjoys helping people.
- Available on the morning of Sunday 8 June 2025 between 8.30am and 12pm.

- Full training and induction will be provided and you will be fully supported in your role.
- You must be aged 16 or over to volunteer at this event, or volunteer with a parent or guardian.
- We will provide all key information required about Ayrshire Athletics Arena and the event.
- No references are required for this role although you will be expected to complete a Criminal Convictions Declaration.
